Councillor Champion Role Profile Older Persons' Champion



The Postholder:-

- A serving MKC Councillor (or former Councillor / Alderman as appropriate) nominated by the Leaders of Political Groups with an interest in championing older persons' issues and their community contribution.
- Some experience of and up to date knowledge of the issues facing older persons would be an advantage.
- Appointed by Council to emphasise the importance the Council places on the role.

The Role:-

- 1. To be a link / contact between Milton Keynes Council and older people in the city.
- 2. To chair the Older Persons' Board which meets quarterly.
- 3. To challenge age discrimination in all forms and to champion, support and promote the contribution, issues and needs of older people within the Council and the wider city.
- 4. To maintain an understanding of older persons' issues and contribution to society, engaging with the voluntary and third sector, to encourage civic engagement opportunities alongside the Mayor and Leader.
- 5. To establish close liaison with the Cabinet / Portfolio holder and Corporate Leadership Team, to ensure Councillors and Officers are aware of and factor older people into policy work (for example dementia friendly cities).
- 6. To work alongside health and social care colleagues to understand and promote:
 - the economic contribution of older persons;
 - the benefits of an active life and maintaining independence; and
 - a positive image for older persons.
- 7. To promote local democratic participation and specifically the involvement, participation and engagement of older persons in the electoral and decision-making process.
- 8. To keep abreast of the evolving impact of national and legislative changes on the sector and to attend training or other developments appropriate.
