**ISSUES/COMMENTS** (including details of any consultations undertaken and any comments received)

The Walton neighbourhood plan has been independently examined by Mr Andrew Ashcroft, whose report was received on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2016.

The findings of the report are that the plan can proceed to referendum subject to modifications. These modifications are mostly relatively minor amendments to the policies in the neighbourhood plan in order to ensure that the plan meets the Basic Conditions.

Milton Keynes Council is proposing two minor modifications to the Plan which do not follow the Examiner's recommendations. These have, in fact, been put forward by the Community Council and are to:

- Policy WNP 4 (Bergamot Gardens) the modification corrects a mistake made in the original plan, by replacing the undefined term 'positive frontage' with the more accepted term 'active frontages'. Active frontages are already defined in the Plan's glossary.
- Policy WNP 12 (Grid Road Corridors) the modification updates the plan to reflect the current planning position following a recent appeal decision at Church Farm.
