Mr John Parmiter, the examiner of the West Bletchley Neighbourhood Plan, produced his report on 20th September 2018. Milton Keynes Council has considered the report and following discussion with the parish council, Milton Keynes Council proposes to accept all of the Examiner's recommendations.

The Examiner's report recommends that a number of changes are made to the submitted Neighbourhood Plan, including new maps to improve the clarity of the plan and its polices, and changing a number of existing policies into non-policy statements of intent where they address non land use planning issues.

West Bletchley Council is currently working with its own planning consultant to update the Neighbourhood Plan and incorporate all of the Examiner's recommendations.

A decision is sought to agree:

- accepting the examiner's recommendations on the West Bletchley Neighbourhood Plan;
- publishing the examiner's report on the Council's website and
- to proceed to arrange a referendum.

Arrangements are being made with Electoral Services to hold a referendum, which is likely to take place in late January/ early February 2019 in order to avoid the Christmas and New Year holiday period.
