# Integrated Curriculum and Financial Planning (ICFP)

ICFP is a management process that helps schools to plan the best curriculum for their pupils with the funding they have available. It can be used at any phase or type of school. ICFP involves measuring your current curriculum, staffing structures and finances, by using this data a 3- to 5-year plan can be created.

## View my Financial Insights (VMFI)

VMFI is an online tool which helps schools view and improve their financial performance. It enables academy trusts and local authorities to see all their schools in one place and provides users with an automated assessment of their data based on similar schools. This assessment identifies areas with the greatest variance, providing users with a helpful starting to point to investigate, potentially leading to improved resource management.
