

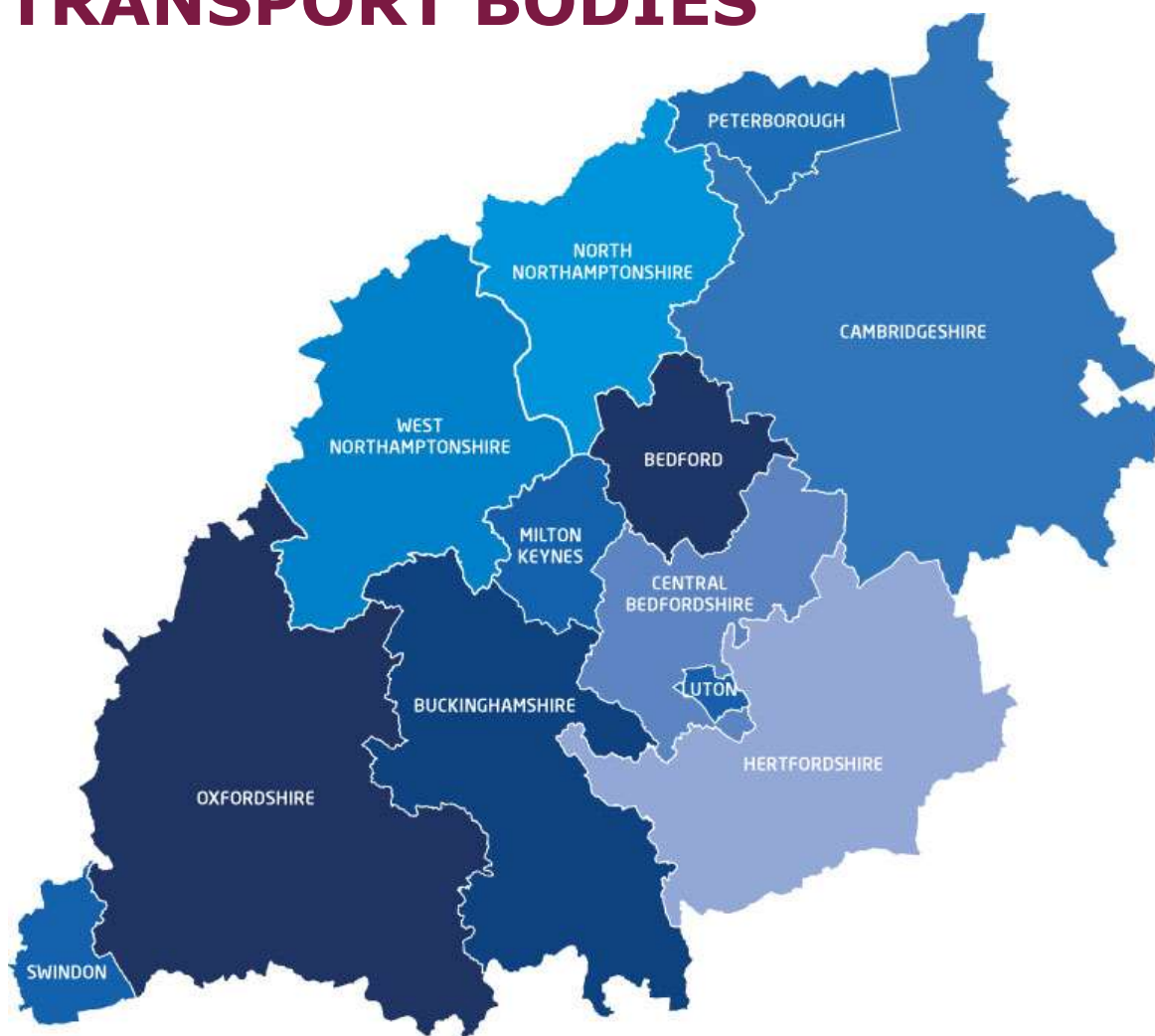

- Delivering better health outcomes



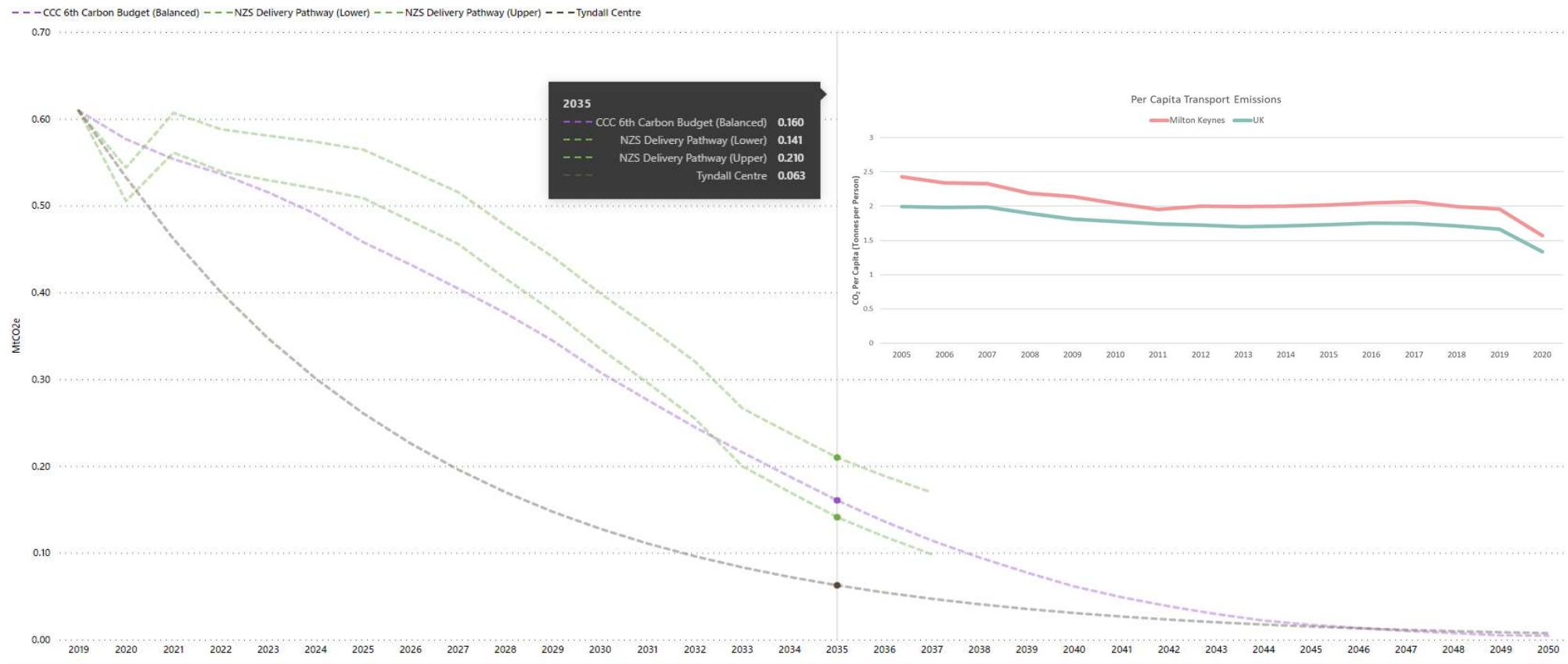

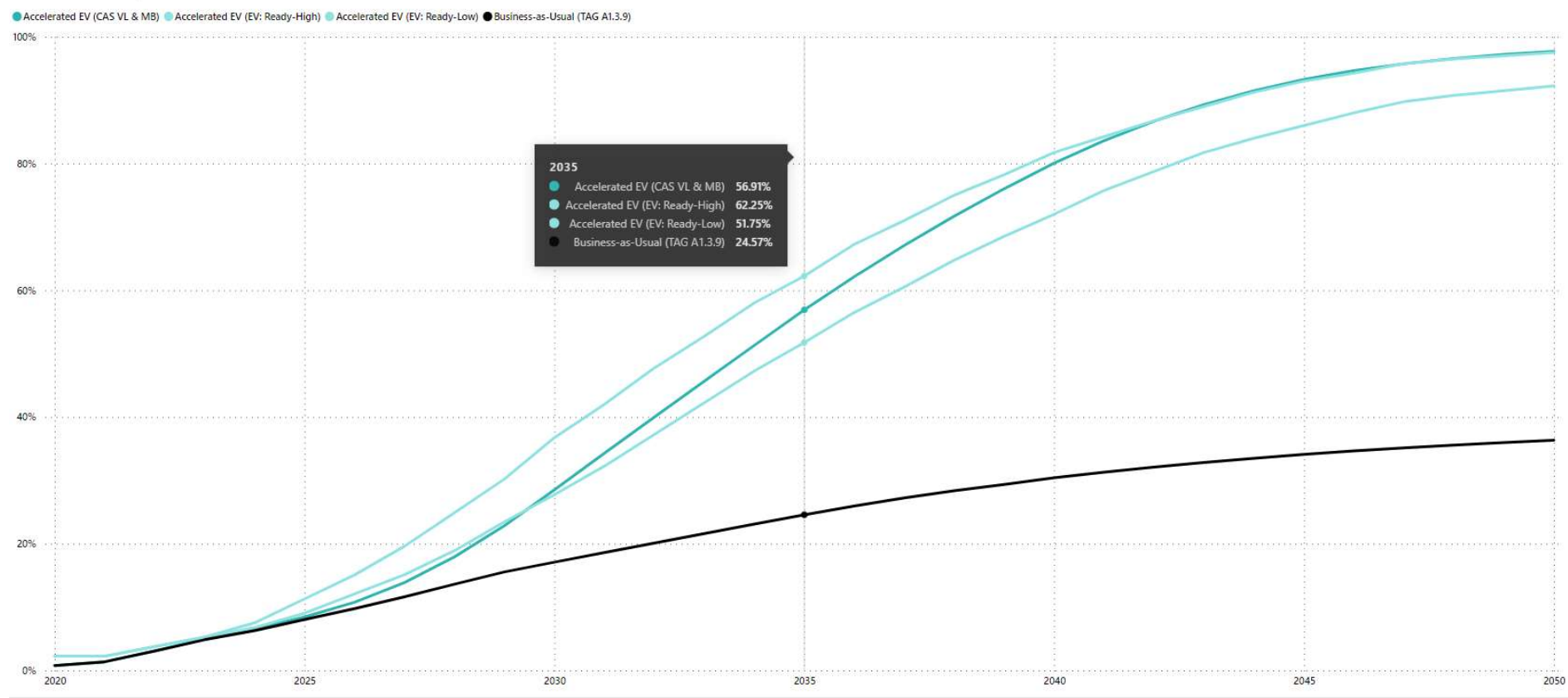

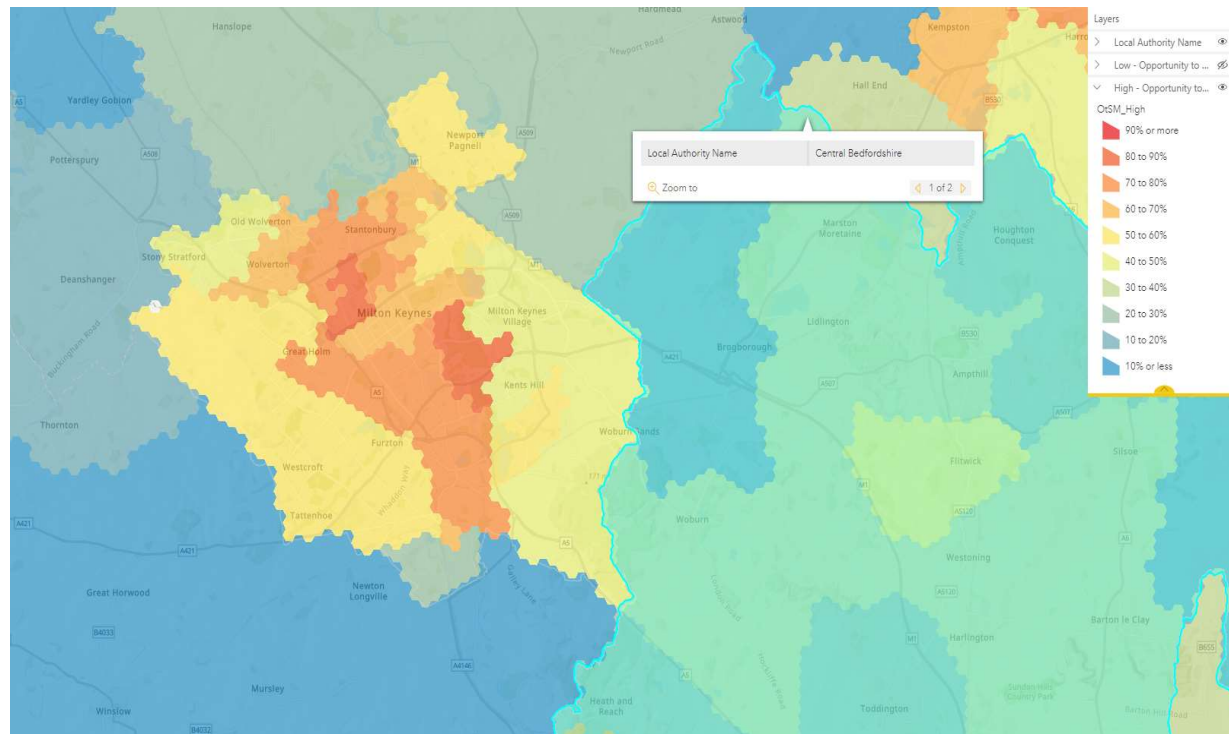

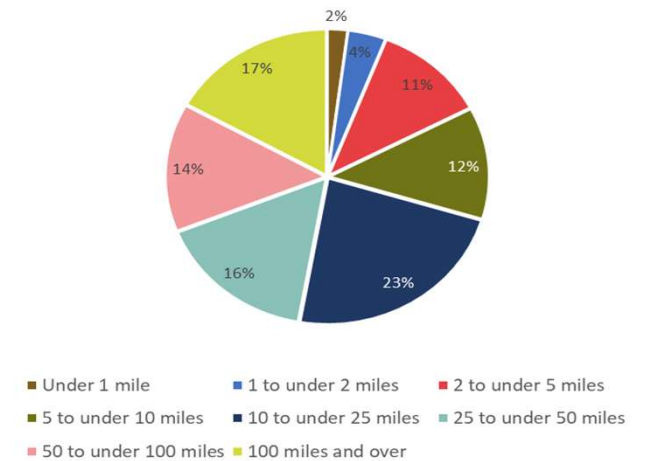
