**Re: Application for the designation of the Woughton Community Council Neighbourhood Plan**

I am writing to advise you that at a meeting of Woughton Community Council on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2013, a decision was made to formally designate the whole of the Woughton Community Council Parish as a neighbourhood area for Neighbourhood Planning purposes.

**The plan area**

Woughton Community Council represents around 13,300 residents living across Netherfield, Beanhill, Eaglestone, Tinkers Bridge, Peartree Bridge, Leadenhall and Coffee Hall in addition to the two industrial areas of Bleakhall and Redmoor.

Woughton Community Council's most recent strategic plan identified poverty as the main priority to be addressed across the Parish and aspires to achieve greater prosperity for the area by providing pathways and routes to individuals and lifting aspirations.


