

Consultation on Neighbourhood Area Application for Stantonbury Parish Council

Milton Keynes Council has received an application for the designation of a neighbourhood area and, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations, 2012, the council is carrying out a 4 week consultation on the proposed Neighbourhood Area from **13th May to 10th June 2015**.

Following the close of the 4 week consultation period, Milton Keynes Council will consider all comments received. A report will then be prepared with a recommendation as to whether or not the proposed Neighbourhood Area should be designated.
