Anti Social Behaviour

Earlier this year representatives from The Estate Renewal Forum, Stony Stratford Town Council, Fullers Slade Resident Association and Milton Keynes City Council walked around the estate looking at fly tipping and potential solutions to reduce anti social behaviour.

Based on this visit plus feedback from residents, partners and stakeholders, they have come up with a list of issues that need resolving. Some of solutions include:

- Bollards to improve safety on footpaths
- CCTV additional cameras to cover crime hotspots including Spider Park

Regeneration and Social Housing Decarbonisation project

We're currently reviewing and exploring options for the regeneration proposals at Fullers Slade. We're committed to renewal work in Fullers Slade and we are pleased to announce we have secured a grant as a contribution to improving council homes in the area.

The improvements will include new doors, new windows, new roofs making the homes more energy efficient and potentially reduce energy costs by up to 50%.

Fullers Slade has also recently benefited from investment in to providing youth services plus the Fullers Club which allows local people and community groups to apply for funding for projects dedicated to the area. MKCC staff have also set up a successful Homework Club and they are working with the Town Council and partners to look at a number of initiatives including community safety projects that could potentially reduce anti-social behaviour in the area.
