

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES) (A509 (PART), EMBERTON) (40 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2006) VARIATION ORDER 2023 (No.2)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 84(1), (2) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to extend the existing 50mph speed limit restriction along A509 to include the following parts of High Street and Gun Lane in Sherington:

- **High Street, Sherington** (both sides) From its junction with A509 for a distance of 1,030 metres in a southerly direction.
- **Gun Lane, Sherington** (both sides) From its junction with High Street for a distance of 460 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The proposed 50mph speed limit comes as a result of concerns from residents of Sherington about speeding when entering the village.

As the Highway Authority for those parts of High Street and Gun Lane in Sherington, Milton Keynes City Council is satisfied that the introduction of the above proposed speed restriction will encourage the convenient and safe movement of vehicular traffic.

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal. Details on how to comment and of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the general arrangements and a statement of reason, may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.
