Back to school

- Starting or returning to nursery or school is an exciting time for all children. As they will be mixing with lots of children, making sure they are up to date with their routine immunisations gives them the best protection from infectious diseases.
- UKSHA has produced reminder postcards, which can be sent or given to parents whose children are due to start or return to school in the autumn term, or nursery. There are also posters that can be used in children's settings. There can be many reasons why children have missed out on their vaccines.
- Reminding parents now and before their children start or return in September gives them time to prioritise making appointments for their child to catch up with their pre-school booster, MMR and make sure they know the signs and symptoms of meningitis and septicaemia.
