The effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce the following parking restrictions in the off-street parking area outside Unity Place in Central Milton Keynes:

- Premium tariff pay at machine or pay by mobile phone parking places
- Disabled person's parking places
- 2-hour free limited waiting parking places
- 5-minute limited waiting parking places (for pick up/drop off)
- Prohibition of waiting except within marked bays
