STATEMENT OF REASONS

(A brief statement of the general nature and effect of the Order)

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

(CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES) (OFF-STREET PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2023

Milton Keynes City Council proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order, under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) along the off-street access roads surrounding the new Moxy Hotel in Central Milton Keynes, which can be accessed via Avebury Boulevard.

Milton Keynes City Council is satisfied that the proposed restrictions will help to alleviate obstruction and encourage a safer environment for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

The Councils reasons for proposing the above Order are as follows: -

- 1) To maintain a safe environment throughout the road, particularly to encourage and facilitate pedestrian and cyclist movements;
- 2) For avoiding danger to people or other traffic using the unadopted roads around the Moxy Hotel, or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.
