## **MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES) (OFF-STREET PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2023**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) along the off-street access roads surrounding the new Moxy Hotel in Central Milton Keynes, which can be accessed via Avebury Boulevard.

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.
