

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

WE, MR CHRIS PHILLIPS AND MRS BEVERLEY PHILLIPS DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are and have been since 15th February 2011 the owners of the land surrounding the village of Weston Underwood within the meaning of the above section more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this statement and thereon edged red.
2. On the 28th day of November Two Thousand and Eleven we deposited with Milton Keynes Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that only those ways marked on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration have been dedicated as public rights of way.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated the 28th day of November Two Thousand and Eleven referred to in 2 above.


