NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council proposes to make the above two Traffic Regulation Orders, under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order will be:

- to introduce no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) along parts of both sides of Manor Drive in Haversham;
- to introduce no stopping during prescribed hours (Monday to Friday, 8.00am to 6.00pm) along part of the north side of Manor Drive in Haversham.

The above proposed restrictions come as a result of road safety concerns expressed by residents during school pick up/drop off times.

The above proposed restrictions will help to alleviate obstruction and encourage a safer environment for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Milton Keynes Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.
