

Co-ordinated scheme for primary school admission September 2025

The council has the responsibility to co-ordinate the admission process for all children starting school for the first time.

This document outlines the scheme to be co-ordinated by the council to support the admission of children starting school for the first time in September 2025 to community, foundation, voluntary controlled, voluntary aided schools and academies.

The following table lists all the infant and primary, foundation and voluntary aided schools and academies in Milton Keynes which are their own admission authority, for whom the council has the responsibility to co-ordinate the admission process:

Timeline for infant/primary admission for September 2025

Admission information circulated to parents 1 September 2024 Application forms, together with any supplementary forms (as required) to be submitted by national closing date 15 January 2025 Details of applications to be sent to infant and primary foundation and VA schools and, academies by 24 February 2025 Foundation and VA school and academies provide the council with ranked lists of all applicants by 14 March 2025 Council to match ranked lists of all schools and allocate places, informing neighbouring councils of offers to be made to applicants resident in their areas by 24 March 2025 Council to notify schools which pupils have been offered places at their school by 15 April 2025 Notification sent to parents 16 April 2025 First re-allocation of places not taken up plus late applications will be notified on 30 May 2025 Second re-allocation of places not taken up plus late applications will be notified on 27 June 2025 Third re-allocation of places not taken up plus late applications will be notified on 17 July 2025 Applications received thereafter will receive an outcome by 31 August 2025

Elements of the Scheme

Information for Parents

As required by law, the council will publish its composite prospectus by 12 September 2024. The prospectus will contain information for the parents of children starting school for the first time in September 2024, including information about:

- Infant and primary schools
- How to express preferences
- How allocations will be made
- Schools' admission criteria
- Where a supplementary form is required by the school
- Deadlines for applications
- How late applications will be handled
- Transfers for pupils with special educational needs
- Home to school transport policy
- Where to access further information

Parents will be able to express preferences for schools in Milton Keynes as well as any preferred schools outside the council boundaries.

The Common Application Form

In the normal admission round, parents will be expected to apply online using the Common Application Form and viewing the composite prospectus. Parents will be provided with a paper copy of the application form on request. The form has a common format.

Parents will be required to:

- Express up to four preferences
- Rank order their preferences
- Give details of siblings who will remain at the school in September 2025
- Give details of the child (address, date of birth, any relevant medical information)
- Indicate if the child has an education, health care plan
- Indicate if the child is in care
- Give any reasons for their preferences
- Name the current early years provision that the child attends
- Give their details (name, address, relationship to the child, contact details)
- Provide proof of their and their child's address.

If additional information is required by governing bodies of foundation or voluntary aided schools or academies in order to apply their admission criteria, this will be detailed in the specific section about that school in the composite prospectus and on

the online and paper copy of the Common Application Form. Contact details for each school are included so parents can obtain any supplementary information forms required from the schools directly.

Parents will be required to apply online by the national closing date, 15 January 2025, or return the paper application form to the council or their child's preferred infant/primary school by 15 January 2025. Supplementary forms must be returned to the individual primary school.

Paper forms can be handed in at any Milton Keynes infant/primary school. The school will be required to date stamp the form and take a copy for their records. The form must then be forwarded immediately to the Access to Education Team.

It is important that parents ensure all the information provided is complete and correct, as the information provided will be what is used to process the application. Any false or misleading information provided may invalidate the application. Whilst there is no duty on the council to validate addresses and any other information provided, we reserve the right to check applications. Any decisions regarding withdrawing applications will be taken by the relevant admission authority. The application may then be withdrawn, requiring a new 'late' application to be made, or may lead to legal action.

Applications for Milton Keynes infant and primary schools

Milton Keynes City Council will ensure that all parents' preferences are logged on the CAPITA ONE admissions system. The Access to Education Team will send all applications to schools in an encrypted electronic data file. Any supplementary information received will also be forwarded.

The application list will be sent to these schools by 24 February 2025.

Applications for infant and primary schools in other council areas and applications for Milton Keynes schools from families living in other council areas

Similar to the process described above, applications for schools in other councils will be logged on the CAPITA ONE system. The Education Access Team will send an electronic data file to the other councils. Any supplementary information received will be forwarded to the relevant council.

Milton Keynes Council will also receive applications from neighbouring councils. These will be recorded and passed to schools in the electronic data entry file.

Protocol for children with an education, health care plan

The Special Educational Needs Team will work with parents of children with an education, health care plan to agree, following transfer review, which school is to be allocated for September 2025.

The Special Educational Needs Team will inform parents of the school allocated for their child by 15 February 2025.

Any allocations for children with an education, health care plan will count against the planned admission number for September 2025.

How a single offer will be determined

The equal preference scheme is the scheme operated by Milton Keynes City Council whereby all preferences listed by the parents/carers on the application are considered under the oversubscription criteria for each school without reference to parental rankings. Where a pupil can be offered a place at more than one school, the rankings are used to determine the single offer by selecting the one ranked highest on the application.

Foundation and voluntary aided schools and academies (as admission authorities) should consider all applications they receive, apply their over-subscription criteria and determine a ranked list.

Ranked lists should be returned via electronic data transfer to Milton Keynes Council by 14 March 2025.

If it is possible to offer a place for a child at more than one of the parents' preferred schools, a place will be offered at the highest ranked school on the application form. This releases places which can be allocated through the reiteration process and ensures that as many applicants as possible are offered a place at one of their preferred schools.

If none of the parents' preferences can be met, a place will be allocated at the nearest school with a place available.

A single place will be identified for each child who has made an application by the end of this process.

Notification of offers to all schools or other councils

Other LAs will be informed by 24 March 2025 of the offers of a school place that Milton Keynes Council will be making to their applicants. All schools will be informed of the final offers, which may include offers made to pupils living in other LA areas, by 15 April 2025.

Offers of a school place to parents by Milton Keynes City Council

The council will contact all parents who live in Milton Keynes giving a single offer of a school place and informing them of their entitlement to appeal, should they not be satisfied with the offer. For those children who have been allocated their first preference school, the Access to Education Team will email details of the allocation of

places by 16 April 2025. For those children who have been allocated a second, third or fourth preference, or allocated a school by the LA, a letter will be sent by second class post by 16 April 2025 providing details of the allocation of places. This is the national notification date.

All parents who applied online will receive an email notification on 16 April 2025.

Waiting lists

If a place is declined at a school of preference then the child's name will automatically be placed on the waiting list for this school. The waiting list will be held and places will be offered (in the event that a place becomes available) in order of the oversubscription criteria and not in order of the date of application. For those schools that use the council's in-year application service, the council will hold and maintain the waiting list until 31 December 2025. Schools that do not use this service will be responsible for holding and maintaining their waiting lists from 1 September 2025.

Late applications received from 16 January 2025 to 31 August 2025

Every effort will be made to encourage parents to complete application forms by the closing date of 15 January 2025. If an application form is not received by 15 January 2025 it will not be possible to consider it until all the other applications have been processed. This means that the majority of school places will have already been allocated. Consideration will be given to parents' preferences, however, if all preferred schools are full, parents will be advised of their right of appeal and a place will be offered at the nearest school with places available.

Applications received from 1 September 2025

Applications received from 1 September 2025 onwards will be considered as in-year applications.

Admission appeals

The council as the admission authority for community and voluntary controlled schools will arrange admission appeals for those schools. Parents should contact the Education Access Team in the event that they wish to appeal against a decision not to offer a place for their child.

Appeal arrangements for foundation and voluntary aided schools and academies are detailed on the schools and council's website.

As the co-ordinator of the process the council hold application information that may be required to support an appeal. If a school which is its own admission authority requires this information for an appeal case a request should be made in writing to primaryadmissions@Milton-keynes.gov.uk,

outlining the information required. Such requests may take up to five working days to be dealt with.
