# MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS AND REDWAYS IN WOLVERTON, STONY STRATFORD, MONKSTON, OLD WOLVERTON AND CALVERTON) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024 

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on $26^{\text {th }}$ March 2024 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, in order to enable Anglian Water to carry out maintenance works between 15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ April 2024 - $\mathbf{2 3}^{\text {rd }}$ April 2024 (24 Hours).

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily close part of:
Lindisfarne Drive, Monkston - At its junction with Tongwell Street.
Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Tongwell Street, Chaffron Way, Flaxley Gate, Blanchard Circle and Lindisfarne Drive (and vice versa).

Signs will be erected in advance of the closure to inform members of the public of the forthcoming closure.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order for Anglian Water will come into effect on $2^{\text {nd }}$ April 2024 and remain in effect for a period of 3 month and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and Residents.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
