Heritage at Risk Register

What is the Heritage at Risk (HAR) Register?

The Conservation and Archaeology Team maintain the Heritage at Risk Register (HAR) for the borough. This register identifies and monitors the condition of heritage assets at risk so that owners and conservation officers may ensure action is taken to safeguard the historic significance of these important places within Milton Keynes.



Bletchley & Fenny Stratford

FENNY STRATFORD MORTUARY CHAPEL

Designation: Non-Designated Heritage Asset

Date Listed: NA

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

Description: Red brick mortuary chapel, with cornerstones and base of local limestone, slate roof, and a hexagonal spire.

Removed: MKCC has undertaken works to make the chapel secure, waterproof and weathertight; no ongoing decay.



Bradwell Abbey

BRADWELL ABBEY CHAPEL

Designation: Grade I Listed Building & Scheduled Ancient Monument

Date Listed: 03/03/1952

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

Description: Former chapel. C14, altered C18. Originally attached to W. wall of church of Priory founded here in 1155.

Removed: July 2020. An extensive project funded jointly by MKCC and Historic England (HE). The chapel is now fully restored with an ongoing conservation management plan in place.

BRADWELL ABBEY FARMHOUSE

Designation: Grade II Listed Building & Scheduled Ancient Monument

Date Listed: 03/03/1952

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

List Description: House, used as a Field Centre. Early C17 probably using some old material, altered late C18- early C19.

Removed: An extensive project funded jointly by MKCC and Historic England (HE). The farmhouse is now fully restored with an ongoing conservation management plan in place.



Bradwell Abbey

BRADWELL ABBEY MEDIEVAL INTERPRETATION CENTRE (MIC)

Designation: Grade II Listed Building & Scheduled Ancient Monument

Date Listed: 03/03/1952

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

List Description: Former farm building, now part of Field Centre. Medieval, C17 and later. Stone, patterned tile roof with dormer each end of W. side, loft entry on left. 1 storey and loft. 4 bays, stable door on left, 2 windows on right.

Removed: An extensive project funded jointly by MKCC and Historic England (HE). The MIC is now fully restored with an ongoing conservation management plan in place.



Loughton

RECTORY FARM, LOUGHTON

Designation: Grade II Listed Building, Conservation Area

Date Listed: 28/08/1975

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: C17 altered C19. Rubble stone, brick to north-east. Hipped old tile roof with brick chimneys, 3 hipped dormers, moulded eaves cornice. 2-storeys and attic.

Removed: Listed building consent granted for the repair and refurbishment of the building following fire. Works now complete.

Olney

ORCHARD HOUSE

Designation: Grade II* Listed Building, Conservation Area

Date Listed: 06/05/1983

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Listing Description: 67 AND 69 Orchard House including front railings. House, 1904 conversion of two C18 houses. Conversion designed by Alexander Ellis Anderson for Joseph William Mann, boot and shoe manufacturer.

Removed: Scheme of works undertaken by owners, building now waterproof and weathertight. No longer considered at risk.



Shenley Brook End WESTBURY FARM

Designation: Grade II Listed Building

Date Listed: 19/03/1986

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: C16 or early C17 largely rebuilt 1670, with later alterations. Timber framed with brick infill to E. wall of S. wing; otherwise brick.

Removed: Scheme of repair and restoration works undertaken by owner.



Shenley Church End

THE BARN, THIRLBY LANE, SHENLEY CHURCH END

Designation: Grade II Listed Building, Conservation Area

Date Listed: 28/08/1975

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: C18 altered, timber framed and weather-boarded on brick plinth with some corrugated iron cladding and brick infill; corrugated iron roof, formerly thatched. 3 openings on E. side, cart doors to west.

Removed: Listed building consent and planning permission for the conversion and extension of the barn to a residential dwelling. Works now complete.



Stantonbury

ST PETER'S CHURCH, STANTON LOW

Designation: Grade II Listed Building

Date Listed: 17/11/1966

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: Ruins of the Church of St Peter.

Removed: MKCC undertook a scheme of repair and stabilisation works to the building.



Stony Stratford

26 / 28 HIGH STREET, STONY STRATFORD

Designation: Grade II Listed Building, Conservation Area

Date Listed: 12/10/1954

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: Earlier house refronted early C18. Tudor mouldings on doorway. Nos 26 and 28 were formerly the Rose and Crown, the reputed site of Edward V's arrest in 1483.

Removed: Formerly derelict and in a state of slow decay the owner has undertaken conservation informed repair and renovation.



Tyringham and Filgrave FILGRAVE CLOCK TOWER

Designation: Grade II Listed Building

Date Listed: 27/02/1984

Ownership: Milton Keynes City Council

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: Tower. 1938 commemorating the Coronation of George VI by Sir Edwin Lutyens. Square tower of brick with stone bands.

Removed: Parish Council sourced and arranged for the cleaning of the tower and repairs to the clockface.



Wolverton

LONGUEVILLE COURT

Designation: Grade II Listed Building

Date Listed: 12/10/1976

Ownership: Private

[National Heritage List Entry](#)

Description: Circa 1729. 2 storey limestone house, ashlar with hipped slate roofs of 2 slopes with stone based chimneys at gable ends.

Removed: Works and repairs undertaken and completed. Building no longer considered at risk.
