

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (HANSLOPE PARK ROAD, HANSLOPE) (TEMPORARY 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 23rd April 2024 the above Order under Section 14(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding along the following part of road at a speed in excess of 40mph whilst Galliford Try carry out construction and development works at Hanslope Park.

Hanslope Park Road, Hanslope – From its junction with Tathall End to its junction with Park Road.

The temporary 40mph speed restriction will be in effect from 29th April 2024 until 25th March 2025 (24 Hours) and shall continue in force for a period of 12 months or until the works have been completed, whichever shall be the earlier. and will only be in force when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed order, other than for emergency services vehicles, and military vehicles whilst being driven on operational duties.

The temporary speed restriction will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the proposed order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
