

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (BULLINGTON END ROAD, CASTLETHORPE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Orders under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles and pedestrians from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following part of **Bullington End Road, Castlethorpe** in order to allow city fiber to install new duct in the carriageway.

As a result of the above works, the following length of road will be closed from **27th May 2025 to 28th May 2025 (24 Hours)**.

Bullington End Road, Castlethorpe – At its junction with Wolverton Road.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Bullington End, Park Road, Gold Street, Castlethorpe Road, Hanslope Road, North Street and Wolverton Road (Vice Versa).

The above closure is scheduled to be implemented on the above dates or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. Signs will be erected several days in advance to warn motorists of the dates and times when the road will be closed.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable these works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on **27th May 2025** and will remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and Residents.

The closure will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
