NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The general effect of the above proposed Order will be to introduce 20mph speed in Tattenhoe, Milton Keynes.

The current speed restriction is 30mph.

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal. Copies of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the general arrangements and a statement of reason, may be inspected on the Council's website at: <u>www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations</u>.
