MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (HORSEFAIR GREEN, STONY STRATFORD – FOLK ON THE GREEN) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 3rd June 2025 made an order for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event, namely, Folk on the Green, which is being promoted by Mrs. June Allen and to enable members of the public to watch the event, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit the following road and footway: -

Vehicles from entering, proceeding or waiting along the whole of Horsefair Green including the suspension of the parking bays, between its junctions with London Road and Calverton Road/Silver Street.

Whilst Horsefair Green is closed the alternative routes will be as follows:

(From Calverton Road/Silver Street to London Road) Via Silver Street, Market Square, Church Street, High Street and London Road

(From London Road to Calverton Road/Silver Street) Via Wolverton Road, Queen Eleanor Street, High Street, Church Street, Market Square and Silver Street.

Pedestrians from entering or proceeding along the footway leading from Cofferidge Close to numbers 13a and 14 Horsefair Green.

Pedestrians from entering or proceeding along the footway leading from Calverton Road to Chestnut Close

The made Order will come into operation on Sunday 15th June 2025 at 7.00am and will continue in operation for a maximum of 3 days or until the completion of the relevant event, whichever shall be the earlier, but it is anticipated that the closure will be in effect until 9.00pm.

Pedestrian access to premises shall be maintained throughout the closure. There shall be no other exemptions from the provisions of the Order other than for emergency services vehicles, military vehicles and vehicles used in connection with this event.

Any person committing a breach of the Order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
