

## MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (MELROSE AVENUE (PART), WEST BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council has on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2025 made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said length of road on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2025 whilst the 'West Bletchley Spring Fayre' festivities takes place. The effects of the closure are as follows:

No vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads and lengths of roads on **Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2025** between the hours of **9:00am and 5:00pm:** 

• **Melrose Avenue, West Bletchley** – from its junction with Dorchester Avenue to its junction with Whaddon Way.

The alternative route for traffic whilst the above length of road is closed will be to proceed via Dorchester Avenue and Whaddon Way (and vice versa).

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles, military service vehicles on operational duties and vehicles being used in connection with or taking part in the 'West Bletchley Spring Fayre' festivities.

The proposed Order will come into effect on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2025 and will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the roads to be closed, subject to provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
