PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (LAVENDON FOOTPATH 5 (PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

On the 26 June 2025, Milton Keynes City Council confirmed the above stated Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the confirmed Order is as follows:-

The effect of that Order as confirmed is to divert part of the existing Public Footpath 5 Lavendon which commences at point A at O.S Grid Reference 490236 256092 in a south-westerly direction for approximately 12 meters to point B at O.S Grid Reference 490226 256083, then continues in a general south-south-easterly direction for approximately 45 meters to point C at O.S Grid Reference 490236 256039. This existing footpath has a length of 57 meters travelling around the eastern perimeter of the Northey farm site. The new footpath route has a length of from point A at O.S Grid Reference 490236 256092 in a southerly direction for approximately 53 meters to point C at O.S Grid reference 490236 256039. The route will have a width of 1.8 meters.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

This Order comes into force on the 25 July 2025, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the 3 July 2025, make an application to the High Court
