

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (MELROSE AVENUE, WHADDON WAY AND SHENLEY ROAD (PARTS), WEST BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends to make an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said lengths of road on Saturday 12th July 2025 whilst the West Bletchley Carnival Procession takes place. The effects of the closure are as follows:

No vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads and lengths of roads on Saturday 12th July 2025 during the stated times:

- **Melrose Avenue, West Bletchley** – from its junction with Whalley Drive to its junction with Whaddon Way (between the hours of 8.00am and 2.00pm)
- **Whaddon Way, West Bletchley** – from its junction with Melrose Avenue to its junction with Shenley Road (between the hours of 12.00pm and 1.00pm)
- **Shenley Road, West Bletchley** – from its junction with Whaddon Way to its junction with Dover Gate (between the hours of 12.00pm and 6.00pm)

The alternative route for traffic whilst the above lengths of road are closed will be to proceed via Dorchester Avenue for the Melrose Avenue Closure and via Church End Road for the Shenley Road closure.

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles, military service vehicles on operational duties and vehicles being used in connection with or taking part in the West Bletchley Carnival Procession.

The proposed Order will come into effect on Saturday 12th July 2025 and will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the roads to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
