

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (FYFIELD BARROW, WALNUT TREE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council has on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, The effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road to allow Anglian Water to carry out valve installation works: -

For the purpose of the above Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from waiting or loading along the following lengths of road:

**28<sup>th</sup> July 2025** (Between 9:30am and 4:00pm)

**Fyfield Barrow, Walnut Tree** - from its junction with Tongwell Street to its junction with The Tawny Owl.

Whilst the above closure is in place the alternative route will be via Fyfield Barrow and Tongwell Street (Vice Versa)

**28<sup>th</sup> August 2025** (Between 9:30am and 4:00pm)

**Fyfield Barrow, Walnut Tree** - from its junction with Tongwell Street to its junction with The Tawny Owl.

Whilst the above closure is in place the alternative route will be via Fyfield Barrow and Tongwell Street (Vice Versa)

The Council is satisfied that the temporary Restriction Order is necessary to enable deliveries to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles of operational duty and Residents.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
