

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

(TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME) (RIDGEWAY (H1) AND TUDOR GARDENS, CALVERTON) 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council proposes under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 to construct a traffic calming measure consisting of a raised table on H1 Ridgeway and Tudor Gardens in Calverton.

The raised tables be situated along H1 Ridgeway and Tudor Gardens in Calverton, from a point 187 metres south-west of its junction with Watling Street, for a distance of 39 metres in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction and will be constructed at a height 75mm and will extend across the entire width of the carriageway.

The Council is now serving formal notification on the proposed traffic calming features and copies of the statement of reason and location plan showing the location of the raised tables may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.

Any representations about or objections to the proposed traffic calming features, together with the grounds upon which they are made, must be made in writing and sent to the Council's Traffic Regulation Order Team at Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Central Milton Keynes, MK9 3EJ, or by email to TROteam@milton-keynes.gov.uk quoting reference NOT-058 and to be received no later than 18th September 2025. Any representations received will be taken into consideration before the implementation of the scheme.
