PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (MARLBOROUGH STREET, SKELDON GATE AND CHILDS WAY MILTON KEYNES) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road to facilitate National Grid to carry out high voltage cable installation works for the MK General Hospital.

10th August 2025 - 10th February 2026

Marlborough Street (Southbound) – From its junction with Childs Way to its junction with Springfield Boulevard.

Whilst the above is in place all closure areas and diversion routes will be added to one.network.

Marlborough Street (Southbound) - From its junction with Childs Way to its junction with Portway.

Whilst the above is in place all closure areas and diversion routes will be added to one.network.

Childs Way (Eastbound and Westbound) – from its junction with Marlborough Street to its junction with South Enmore Roundabout

Skeldon Gate - From its junction with Portway to its junction with Silbury Boulevard

Whilst the above is in place all closure areas and diversion routes will be added to one.network.

Warning signs will be erected several days in advance to inform the public of the forthcoming closure.

Only one closure will be in place at one time.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable site investigation to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 10th August 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 6 months and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
