

STATEMENT OF REASONS

(A brief statement of the general nature and effect of the Order)

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

(TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME) (RIDGEWAY (H1) AND TUDOR GARDENS, CALVERTON) 2025

The effect of the above notice will be to inform the general public that the Council intends to construct traffic calming measure consisting of a raised table on H1 Ridgeway and Tudor Gardens in Calverton under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980.

The raised tables will be positioned from a point 187 metres south-west of its junction with Watling Street, for a distance of 39 metres in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction and will be constructed at a height 75mm and will extend across the entire width of the carriageway.

The Councils reason for introducing the above traffic calming measure is road safety, and in particular reducing vehicular speeds on approach to the new redway crossing point on H1 Ridgeway, which will encourage and facilitate safe pedestrian movements.

The Council considers it expedient to introduce the traffic calming measures:

- to facilitate the expeditious, convenient, and safe movement of pedestrians along H1 Ridgeway and Tudor Gardens in Calverton.
- for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
