

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (FARTHING GROVE, NETHERFIELD) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 2nd September 2025 made an Order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said lengths of road on Saturday 6th September 2025 whilst the Woughton Family Festival 2025

No vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads and lengths of roads on Saturday 6th September 2025 during the stated times:

- **Farthing Grove, Netherfield** – Between 122 Farthing Grove and 158 Farthing Grove (between the hours of 7:00am and 5.00pm)

The alternative route for traffic whilst the above lengths of road are closed will be to proceed via Barnfield Drive, Saxon Street and Buckland Drive.

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles, military service vehicles on operational duties and vehicles being used in connection with or taking part in the Netherfield Festival 2024.

The proposed Order will come into effect on Saturday 6th September 2025 and will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the roads to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
