The **start date** for the above Order is **20 October2025**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Orders if confirmed as made, will divert part of the existing public footpath, Hanslope Footpath 11 from point A at O.S Grid Reference SP 79745 46438 in a general south westerly direction for approximately 282 metres to point B at O.S Grid Reference SP 79570 46219 and is shown by a bold black continuous line on the Order map, to a line running from point A at O.S Grid Reference SP 79745 46438 in a general south easterly direction for approximately 17 metres to point C at OS Grid Reference SP 79757 46426, then in a general south westerly direction for approximately 145 metres to point D at OS Grid Reference SP 79702 246295. The new footpath will have a length of approximately 162 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout and is shown by a bold black dashed line on the Order map.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [15 December 2025]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation or any other person wishing to make representations in writing must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [26 January 2026]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (HANSLOPE FOOTPATH 11 (PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by Milton Keynes City Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

The Applicant has agreed to defray any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Hanslope and shown by a bold black continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order, where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted, there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across the path belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they then had.
- There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order public footpath over the land situate at Hanslope described in Part 2 of the Schedule to

this Order and shown by a bold black broken line on the map contained in this Order.

Existing Hanslope Footpath 11 (Part):-

Description of site of new path or way

New Hanslope Footpath 11 (Part):-

From point A at O.S Grid Reference SP 79745 46438 in a general south easterly direction for approximately 17 metres to point C at OS Grid Reference SP 79757 46426, then in a general south westerly direction for approximately 145 metres to point D at OS Grid Reference SP 79702 246295. The footpath will have a length of approximately 162 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout and is shown by a bold black dashed line on the map (points A-C-D)
