

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (BOW BRICKHILL TO LITTLE BRICKHILL ROAD, BOW BRICKHILL) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following lengths of road to allow National Highways to undertake resurfacing and sign replacement works.

For the purpose of the above Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait in or proceed along the following length of road:-

20th – 25th October 2025

(overnight 9pm – 6am)

Bow Brickhill to Little Brickhill Road, Bow Brickhill – from its junction with Watling Street for 525 metres in a northerly direction.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via unnamed road between Bow Brickhill to Little Brickhill Road and Sheep Lane and Sheep Lane or A5 and Watling Street (and vice versa).

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 20th October 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure. Signs will be erected several days in advance to inform the public of the forthcoming closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
