

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADES, VARIOUS ROADS, MILTON KEYNES) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council, with the consent of Central Bedfordshire Council, intends to make an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in various roads within areas of Milton Keynes whilst the annual Remembrance Day parades take place. The effect of this is that no vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads or parts of roads within the following areas in Milton Keynes between Sunday 9th November 2025 and Tuesday 11th November 2025 during the times stated below: -

Sunday 9th November 2025

WAVENDON

- **From 09.45 am to 10.20 am**

Walton Road - From its junction with Stockwell Lane to its junction with St Mary's Close.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the alternative route will be via Newport Road, Dankworth Lane and Stockwell Lane (and vice versa).

WEST BLETCHLEY

- **From 10.00 am to 12.30 pm**

Church Green Road - from its junction with Buckingham Road to its junction with Rickley Lane.

The alternative route will be via Church Green Road, Shenley Road, Buckingham Road and vice versa.

BLETCHLEY

- **From 08.30 am to 10.30am**

Queensway - from its junction with Princes Way to its junction with Victoria Road.

The alternative route will be via Princes Way, Tavistock Street, North Street, Victoria Road and vice versa.

CASTLETHORPE

- **From 9.00am to 9.45am**

North Street - from each of its junctions with South Street.

The alternative route will be via South Street.

NEWPORT PAGNELL

- **From 10.00am to 12.00pm**

High Street - from its junction with Queens Avenue roundabout to Ousebank Street roundabout. Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Ousebank Street, River Side, St Johns Street, Silver Street, Bury Street (and vice versa)

The following HGV diversion routes will apply: -

Westbound traffic approaching from Northampton Road should proceed via Northampton Road, Sherington Road, Chicheley Hill, A509 Newport Pagnell Bypass, H3 Monks Way and Marsh End Road.

Eastbound traffic approaching from Wolverton Road/Marsh End Road should proceed via Marsh End Road, H3 Monks Way, A509 Newport Pagnell Bypass, Chicheley Hill, Sherington Road and Northampton Road

OLNEY

- **From 10.30am to 11:30am**

Market Place, Silver End, Palmers Road and Coneygere

The alternative route will be via High Street, Holes Lane, and East Street (and vice versa)

WOBURN SANDS

- **From 10.30 am to 10.50 am**

Church Road From its junction with High Street to a point level with St Michael's Church.

- **From 10.30 am to 11.30 am**

High Street from its junction with Hardwick Road to its junction with Russell Street.

The alternative route will be via Aspley Hill, Weathercock Lane, and Russell Street, Station Road, Theydon Avenue, The Leys, Hardwick Road.

NEW BRADWELL

- **From 1.50 pm and 3.00 pm**

Newport Road – From its junction with Wood Street to the mini roundabout at the junction with Newport Road next to Sid Telfers.

From 1.50 pm and 3.00 pm

Newport Road – Entire Length including slip road in front of Sid Telfers, Newport Road from the East side of Stonebridge Roundabout, Junction V6 Grafton Street and Newport Road to the mini roundabout junction of Wooton Court and Glyn Street, Church Street from the junction with Newport Road to the junction with High Street

Diversion Eastbound – The alternative route will be via Grafton Street Southbound, Mathiesen Road, Bradwell Road, Newport Road

Diversion Westbound - The alternative route will be via Bradwell Road, Mathiesen Road, Grafton Street, Monks Way, Grafton Street, Newport Road

WOLVERTON

- **From 9.00am to 12.30pm**

The Square, Wolverton All Roads

The alternative route will be via access Roads on Buckingham Street and Aylesbury Street (and vice versa)

STONY STRATFORD

- **From 2.30 pm to 4.00 pm**

High Street – from The Cock Hotel to Silver Street

The alternative route will be via Silver Street and Church Street (and vice versa)

Tuesday 11th November 2025

CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES

From 10.30 am to 10.50 am

Midsummer Boulevard (South Side) from its junctions with Marlborough Gate to its junction with North Twelfth Street.

COFFEE HALL

From 9.30am to 11.30am

Jonathans – From its junction with Lloyds to its junction with Woughton Community Council

The alternative route will be via Garraways and St Dunstons

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency services vehicles on operational duties. The proposed Order will affect all classes of vehicle.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those lengths of road to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
