MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (FLITTON COURT (PART), STONY STRATFORD) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 28th October 2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. This order is to enable BT to carry out excavations to undertake ducting works.

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily close part of:

4th – 7th November 2025

(24 hours)

Flitton Court, Stony Stratford – from outside number 25 to its dead end.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, there will be no alternative route, however access will be provided where safe to do so.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 4th November 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 6 months and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
