## MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, WOLVERTON – WOLVERTON FIREWORKS DISPLAY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2025 made an order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to implement road closures for the purpose of preventing obstruction, and in case of fall out from fireworks, whilst the annual Wolverton Fireworks Display takes place. The locations of the closures are as follows: -

- Junction of Windsor Street connecting to Stratford Road
- Junction of Church Street connecting to Windsor Street
- Junction of Western Road connecting to Windsor Street
- Junction of Furze Way connecting to Windsor Street
- Junction of Stratford Road connecting to Jersey Road
- Junction Stratford Road connecting to Anson Road
- Junction Stratford Road connecting to McCorquordale Road
- Junction Stratford Road connecting to Christchurch Grove
- Junction Stratford Road connecting to Wodell Drive
- Junction of Stratford Road connecting to Trinity Road
- Junction Stratford Road connecting to Harnett Drive
- Junction of Old Wolverton Road to Trinity Road
- Junction of Old Wolverton Road connecting to Longville
- Junction of Old Wolverton Road connecting to Empress Matilda Gardens
- Junction of Old Wolverton Road connecting to King Stephen Meadows
- Length of Great Monks Street to be closed from roundabout from Stratford Road up to Hodge Lea Roundabout
- Junction Addington Avenue connecting to Greenleys Roundabout
- Junction Ridgeway connecting to Greenleys Roundabout
- Junction Wilkinson Crescent connecting to V5 Great Monks Street
- Junction Field Lane connecting to V5 Great monks Street
- Junction Greenleys Lane connecting to V5 Great Monks Street
- Junction Gloucester Road connecting to V5 Great Monks Street
- Junction Marron Lane connecting to Gloucester Road
- All alleyways leading from Stratford Road into Victorian Wolverton, from the west of Windsor Street to be closed, off Stratford Road.

The above closures will be in effect between the hours of 4.30pm and 8.00pm on 5th November 2025.

There will be no alternative routes available whilst the above roads are closed.

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the order except for emergency services and organisers in connection with the fireworks display and disabled people.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the Order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
