MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN MILTON KEYNES) (MILTON KEYNES BOWL FIREWORKS DISPLAY 2025) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 28th November 2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) (b) and 14 (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, because of the likelihood of danger to the public and in the interests of safety and as a means of segregating traffic from pedestrians during the Fireworks Display event being staged at the MK National Bowl in Milton Keynes. It is anticipated that the following restrictions will be in effect on the dates and times shown below and when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs:

To temporarily close the following lengths of grid road:

1st November 2025 (6:00pm - 11:00pm)

Watling Street (V4) between Elfield Park Roundabout and Knowlhill Roundabout.

Chaffron Way (H7) between Leadenhall Roundabout and Furzton Roundabout.

Grafton Street (V6) between Leadenhall Roundabout and Bleak Hall Roundabout

Standing Way (H8) between Elfield Park Roundabout and Bleak Hall Roundabout

To temporarily close the following lengths of estate road:

1st November 2025 (6:00pm - 11:00pm)

Davy Avenue, Knowlhill – From its junction with Harrison Close to its junction with Chaffron Way

Favell Drive, Furzton – From its junction with Barleycroft to its junction with Watling Street

To temporarily close the following lengths of Bridleway from

1st November 2025 (6:00pm – 11:00pm)

Bridleway 32, Loughton - From its junction with Chaffron Way to its junction with Spring Rose Way.

To temporarily restrict the speed limit to **20mph** on the following lengths of roads:

1st November 2025 (6:00pm – 11:00pm)

Watling Street (V4) between Childs Way and Standing Way.
Chaffron Way (H7) between Fulmer Street and Grafton Street.
Davy Avenue, Knowlhill (its entire length)
Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall (its entire length)

Whilst the above event is taking place there will be a one-way system in operation on the following length of road – Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall.

Temporary parking restrictions will be in place on the following roads:

1st November 2025 (6:00pm – 11:00pm)

- V3 Fulmer Street from its junction with H6 Childs Way to its junction with H8 Standing Way
- V4 Watling Street from its junction with H6 Childs Way to its junction with H10 Bletcham Way
- H6 Childs Way from its junction with V3 Fulmer Street to its junction with V6 Grafton Street.
- H7 Chaffron Way from its junction with V3 Fulmer Street to its junction with V6 Grafton Street.
- V6 Grafton Street from its junction with H6 Childs Way to its junction with H8 Standing Way
- H8 Standing Way from its junction with V3 Fulmer Street to its junction with V6 Grafton Street
- Chesney Wold [Entire Length]
- Summerston Road [Entire Length]
- Davy Avenue [Entire Length]
- Roebuck Way [Entire Length]
- Kelvin Drive [Entire Length]
- Harrison Close [Entire Length]
- Shirwell Crescent [Entire Length]
- Seebeck Place [Entire Length]
- Phoenix Drive [From its junction with V6 Grafton Street, to its junction with Marine Court]
- Chapter [From its junction with Grafton Street to its junction with Rochfords]
- Parkside [From its junction with H8 Standing Way to Favell Drive]

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary in the interest of public safety. The temporary Order shall come into operation at 00:01am on 1st November 2025 and shall continue in force for a period of up to 3 months or until the event have been completed, whichever shall be the earlier.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and any vehicles connected with the event operations.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the events taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
