MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (STERLING CLOSE PERNNYLAND) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road. To allow Openreach to carry out fiber cabling works.

Sterling Close, Pennyland - Outside Number 31

The above closure will come into effect between 25th November 2025 – 28th November 2025 (**Between 9:30am and 3:30pm each day**).

Access will be maintained.

The temporary road closure and diversion route can be viewed at https://one.network/

The Council is satisfied that a temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 25th November 2025 and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
