PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (BULLINGTON END AND BULLINGTON END ROAD, CASTLETHORPE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 25th November 2025 made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along that part of the following roads to allow Openreach to carryout cable recovery works.

1st December 2025 – 5th December 2025 (between 9:30am and 3:30pm each day)

Bullington End, Castlethorpe – from its junction with Manor farm to its junction with Wolverton Road

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the alternative route will be via Park Road, Gold Street, Castlethorpe Road, Hanslope Road, North Street, Wolverton Road (and vice versa).

Bullington End Road, Castlethorpe – From its junction with Glenmore Farm to its junction with Bullington End.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the alternative route will be via Wolverton Road, Bullington End (and vice versa).

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency services vehicles and military vehicles being driven on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

The temporary closure will be in force on the date shown when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs displayed in the affected part of road.

All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closure at least one week prior to works taking place.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 1st December 2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 3 month or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works are not completed within the maximum period stated, a further order may be made.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
