

Notice of landowner deposit under section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 Milton Keynes City Council ('the Authority')

An application to deposit a map and statement and subsequently lodge a declaration under section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 has been made in relation to the land (or lands) described below and shown edged in yellow on the accompanying map.
