

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

(THE UNNAMMED ROAD PARALLEL TO A421 STANDING WAY) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2026

WHEREAS Milton Keynes City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under section 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (the Act of 1984) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

PART 1

DEFINITIONS, COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION

1. This Order may be cited as “Milton Keynes City Council (The Unnamed Road Parallel to A421 Standing Way) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2026” and shall come into force on the day of 2026.
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the same meanings respectfully assigned to them:-

“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 185 (1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

“electric vehicle” means any vehicle which uses one or more electric motors for propulsion;
3. The plan annexed to this Order identifies the length of road described in the Schedule to this Order, provided that where there is any inconsistency between the plan and the wording in that Schedule, it is the wording of the Schedule which shall prevail.
4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order any provisions of any Orders mentioned in Part 2 hereto are hereby revoked to the extent stated in that Part.

PART 2

REVOCATIONS

5. The following Order is **HEREBY REVOKED** in its entirety:-

PART 3

PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

6. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle or electric vehicle to proceed along any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at any time.
7. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order, shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to proceed in any of the lengths of roads; or is being used:
- (a) for police, military, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) For the purpose of maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said roads;
 - (c) For the purpose of any building operation including the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road or any main, pipe, or apparatus for supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) In the service of a local authority, water authority or other statutory authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties of an emergency nature;
 - (e) with the consent of an Officer of Milton Keynes City Council or a Police Officer in uniform.

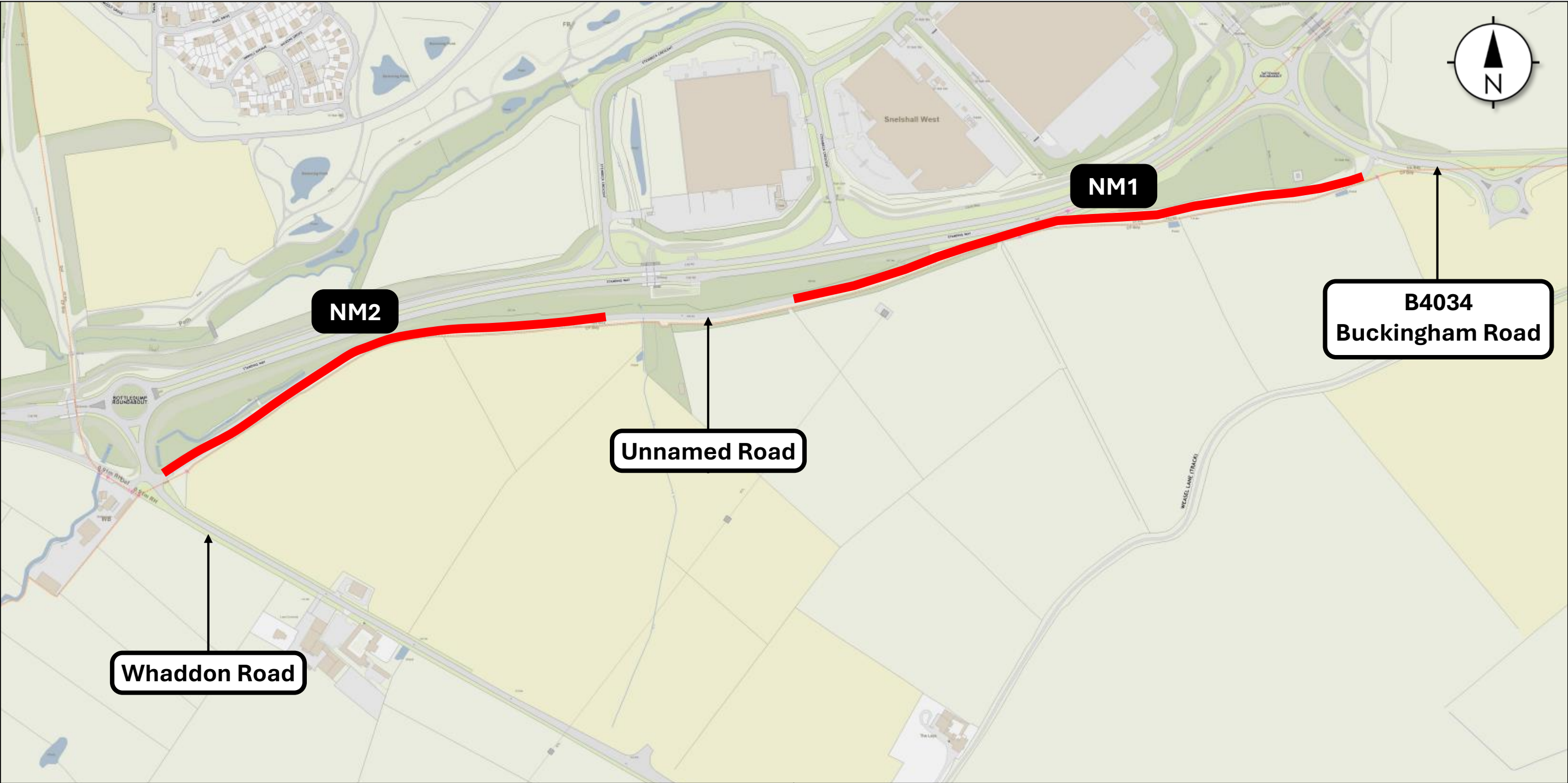
PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Reference	Road Name	Length of Road
NM1	The unnamed road that runs parallel to A421 Standing Way that links B4034 Buckingham Road and Whaddon Road	From a point 35 metres west of its junction with B4034 Buckingham Road, for a distance of 677 metres in a westerly direction
NM2	The unnamed road that runs parallel to A421 Standing Way that links B4034 Buckingham Road and Whaddon Road	From a point 10 metres east of its junction with Whaddon Road, for a distance of 637 metres in an easterly direction
