

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL**

(VARIOUS ROADS, MILTON KEYNES)

(40 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1), (2), (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The general effect of the above proposed Order will be:

- To revoke the current Order entitled **“Milton Keynes City Council (Various Roads, Haversham) (50 mph Speed Restriction) Order 2024”** and consolidate the 50mph speed restrictions along parts of Bullington End Road and Wolverton Road (Castlethorpe), Park Road (Hanslope and Hanslope Park) and the unnamed road that links Tathall End and Haversham;
- To revoke the existing 40mph speed limit on the unnamed road that links High Street and Wolverton Road, Haversham – this part of the unnamed road will become 30mph by virtue of street lighting;
- To introduce 40mph speed restrictions along parts of Haversham Road (Haversham), Park Road and Newport Road (Hanslope, Hanslope Park and Tathall End), the unnamed road that links Tathall End and Hanslope Park and the unnamed road that links Tathall End and Gayhurst.

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.
