88344 H10 Canal Bridge Sub-Structure Drainage Remedial Works

Milton Keynes City Council (MKCC) will be carrying out essential structural maintenance works on the H10 Canal Bridge (underside) on Simpson Road. These works will require full road closures on Simpson Road.

About the Works

These essential works are required to maintain the structural integrity and safety of the H10 Canal Bridge. The works, delivered by MKCC's Highways service provider Ringway, include:

- Vegetation Clearance/Tree removal
- Protective Coating to the east abutment
- Revetment concrete slabs repairs
- Drainage Installation
- Connect piped drainage to soakaways at the bottom of the slope.

Planned Construction Dates

The works are programmed to commence from Monday, 2nd March to Friday, 1 May 2026.

Traffic Management & Access


- Full road closures on Simpson Road will be in place for the Sub-Structure Drainage Remedial Works
- Diversion routes will be clearly signed and managed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.
