NPTC wishes to submit the following comments in response to the Reg 19 consultation.

1. The most significant change from the current PlanMK is that now Newport Pagnell is included with the MK City boundary, and not part of the rural area. Policy GS1 and Key Diagram apply. Newport Pagnell has always been part of the 'rural north' of Milton Keynes and the Town Council strongly objects to this new designation. The Town Council request that this is reverted.
2. The allocation of Eastern Strategic City Extension for 16,000 new dwellings, including 7750 by 2025, extends the current MK East area almost as far as Chicheley Hill, Chicheley and North Crawley, and surrounds Moulsoe village, taking development up to the Borough boundary near Cranfield University. There is no other detail of timing or suggested layout, as occurs with some of the other site allocations. NPTC requests this detail be made available.
