10) Prescribed Fee:- The initial fee payable is £488 to process the application. A grant fee is then payable following the successful consultation and is calculated by taking the maximum number of additional hours required in excess of 1 hour in every 24-hr period and Multiplying it by £53. <u>EXAMPLE</u> Monday - Friday 3 additional hours Saturday - 3 additional hours Sunday - Closed Initial Fee Due = £488 When application due to be granted: 3 hrs x £53 = £159 Combined cost = £647	Trading Hours proposed (specific timings are required) Monday Tuesday Wednesday Thursday Friday Saturday Sunday £488 Process fee + Max number of Hrs x £53 Total Due = £

Please note there is no right of appeal against any council decision made in respect of a street trading consent. It is your responsibility to obtain separate permission from the landowner concerned whether this application is granted or not (including when the land is under Council control / ownership). A consent does not confer the right to trade in any place contrary to parking restrictions imposed by Highway, Road, Traffic or similar legislation.
