(VARIOUS ROADS, MILTON KEYNES)

(40 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2026 (No.2)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1), (2), (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order.

The general effect of the above proposed Order will be:

- To introduce 50mph speed restrictions along parts of Danstead Way (H4), Portway (H5) and Chaffron Way (H7);
- To introduce a 50mph speed restriction along parts of Grafton Street (V6), which will link to the existing 50mph speed restriction on the south-eastbound carriageway on Grafton Street between Danstead Way (H4) and Portway (H5).

Milton Keynes City Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal. Copies of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the general arrangements and a statement of reason, may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.
