I am really very concerned about the traffic on the A5 and the A4146. These are already very busy and adding thousands more cars will make this grid locked. It will also mean that villages like Great Brickhill will become traffic 'rat runs' - this will destroy the village and is unsafe. Great Brickhill does not have paving on roadways in the village. I am also very concerned about the destruction of green space and the impact that this will have on the (Great) Brickhills Attractive Area. The aspirational connection leading towards the woodland is of particular concern as it looks like it will lead to John Horncapps road. This is totally unsuitable for anything other than occasional traffic. I feel that this whole scheme is totally lacking consideration for the local villages. The traffic will be dangerous, heavy and unsuitable to a rural area such as this.
