

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (MIDSUMMER BOULEVARD (PART), CENTRAL MILTON KEYNES) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council intends to make an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said length of road on Sunday 21st June 2026 whilst the 'Midsummer Festival' takes place. The effects of the closure are as follows:

No vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads and lengths of roads on **Sunday 21st June 2026** between the hours of **6:00am and 11:59pm**:

- **Midsummer Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes** (and its access roads) – from its junction with Marlborough Gate to a point level with Lower Twelfth Street.

The alternative route for traffic whilst the above length of road is closed will be to proceed via Marlborough Gate, Avebury Boulevard and Lower Twelfth Street (and vice versa).

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles, military service vehicles on operational duties and vehicles being used in connection with or taking part in the 'Midsummer Festival'.

The proposed Order will come into effect on Sunday 21st June 2026 and will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the roads to be closed, subject to provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
