

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

**MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL  
(BRIDGE STREET, CHURCH STREET, NEWPORT ROAD, OLD NEWPORT  
ROAD (SLIP ROAD), CORNER PIN, THOMPSON STREET, HARWOOD STREET,  
BRADWELL ROAD AND HIGH STREET, NORTH STREET, NEW BRADWELL)  
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council intends to make an order under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the above roads whilst the annual New Bradwell Combined School Carnival Procession takes place. The temporary closure will be in operation between 12.00pm and 1.00pm on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2026 and its effects will be as follows: -

No vehicles shall be permitted to proceed along that part of North Street from its junction with Bradwell Road to its junction with Thompson Street, Bridge Street from its junction with New Bradwell Combined School to its junction with Church Street, along Church Street from its junction with Bridge Street to its junction with Newport Road, along Newport Road from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Thompson Street, along Thompson Street from its junction with Newport Road to its junction with Harwood Street, along Harwood Street from its junction with Thompson Street to its junction with Bradwell Road, along Bradwell Road from its junction with Harwood Street to its junction with High Street, along High Street from its junction with Bradwell Road to its junction with Church Street, along Church Street from its junction with High Street to its junction with Newport Road, along Newport Road from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Old Newport Road (slip road), along Old Newport Road around Corner Pin to its junction with Newport Road, along Newport Road to its junction with Church Street, along Church Street from its junction with Newport Road to its junction with Bridge Street and along Bridge Street ending at its junction with New Bradwell Combined School grounds.

All the above roads, with the exception of the said lengths of Newport Road and High Street, will re-open as soon as the procession has passed through them.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed order except for emergency services vehicles and military vehicles, and those vehicles taking part in the New Bradwell Combined School Carnival Procession. Residents will be provided with access at all times.

The proposed order will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those parts of the road to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
