

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (A509 (PART), OLNEY) (TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 30th June 2026 made an order under Section 14(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from proceeding along **A509, Olney** (from a point 75 metres south-west of its junction with Lime Street, Olney, continuing for a distance of 450 metres in a south-westerly direction) at a speed in excess of 30mph, whilst the Olney Riverfest Event takes place, because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The temporary 30mph speed restriction will be in effect from 11.30am to 2.30pm on Sunday 5th July 2026 and will **only** be in force when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed order, other than for emergency services vehicles, and military vehicles whilst being driven on operational duties.

The temporary speed restriction will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the proposed order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
