

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL

**(TANNERS DRIVE, V10 BRICKHILL STREET (PART), BLAKELANDS, WOLVERTON ROAD (PART), HIGH STREET (PART), ST JOHN STREET, TICKFORD STREET (PART), SEVERN DRIVE (PART), TRENT DRIVE (PART) AND DOVE CLOSE, NEWPORT PAGNELL) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Milton Keynes City Council has on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026 made an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said roads and lengths of roads whilst the Newport Pagnell Carnival Procession takes place. The effects of the closure are as follows:

No vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads and lengths of roads within Blakelands and Newport Pagnell, Milton Keynes whilst the carnival proceeds through them:- Tanners Drive, Blakelands to its junction with the V10 Brickhill Street, along Brickhill Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Wolverton Road at the Giffard Park Roundabout; along Wolverton Road through to High Street, Newport Pagnell then along High Street to its junction with St John Street; along St John Street, through to Tickford Street to its second junction with the Severn Drive adjacent to Chartwell House; then along Severn Drive to its junction with Trent Drive, continuing along Trent Drive until the parade enters Riverside Meadow at Dove Close between the hours of **11:50am and 2:00pm on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

There shall be no other alternative routes as the temporary restrictions will only apply whilst the Newport Pagnell Carnival Procession passes along the above roads and lengths of roads.

There shall be no exemptions from the provisions of the Order except for emergency services vehicles, military vehicles being driven whilst on operational duties and vehicles being used in connection with or taking part in the Newport Pagnell Carnival Procession.

The Order will affect all classes of vehicles.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to the roads to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
